LEAGUE MEMBER OF THE YEAR

INTRODUCTION

1. At each Annual General Meeting, The Army Cadet League of Canada (ACLCL) will honour a member in good standing who has performed exemplary service to the League at the national or the provincial/territorial level.
2. The Award will take the form of a leather portfolio case embossed with the badge of the League and "Member of the Year – 20XX - Membre de l'année".

AUTHORITY

3. Approving authority for this award shall be the Executive Committee of the ACLCL whose decision shall be final.

SELECTION CRITERIA

4. The following criteria shall be used as a guide in determining the nomination and final selection of the Member of the Year:
 - a. Dedication and active service to the ACLCL over a period of years;
 - b. Completion of a major task that benefited the ACLCL and which brought credit or efficiencies to the ACLCL and/or the Royal Canadian Army Cadets;
 - c. The member exhibits personal qualities that serve as a role model for other members and cadets;
 - d. A member may receive this award more than once.

SELECTION

5. Nominations may be made by any President of a Branch of the Army Cadet League of Canada or by a member of the National Council of the ACLCL. The nomination shall be by letter or email in the form of a "citation". Nominations shall close on March 1st, annually. Selection shall take place as soon as possible after the close of nominations.

NOTIFICATION

6. Winners of the award shall be notified by their Branch President or, if a national member, by the National President.
