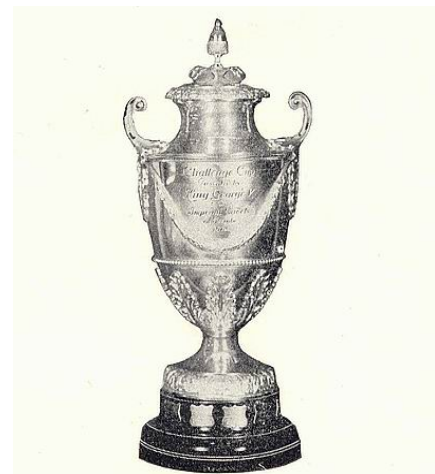
NATIONAL MARKSMANSHIP AWARDS (OVERVIEW)

1. There shall be two awards sponsored by The Army Cadet League of Canada (ACLC) at the National Marksmanship Competition:
 - to the top Army Cadet Team (The George V Cup), and
 - to the Top aggregate Army Cadet (Shooting Jacket).
2. These awards shall be decided by Competition Staff whose decision shall be final.
3. The George V Cup (retained at the National Office) shall be shipped in its shipping case to the competition staff on location. Team winning plates shall be added annually, and a list of winners maintained by the National Office. Keeper plaques for each team member (including the coach) will consist of a silver bar (wafer), engraved with the competition details and framed in a shadow box. On the reverse of the box shall be an explanation of the tradition of awarding marksmanship winners with the "Sovereign's Silver".
4. The Top aggregate Army Cadet shall be recognized by the award of a shooting jacket. A sample jacket shall be provided for presentation purposes and a made to measure jacket shall be provided to the cadet at a later date.

This trophy was re-introduced at the National Marksmanship Competitions in 2006 for the top Army Cadet team.



KING GEORGE V CUP

Awarded annually to the Military area having the highest percentage of firers per enrolled cadets in the Miniature Rifle Matches for the Youth of the Empire and held by the team that obtained the highest scoring average.
