A serving cadet must have successfully completed four calendar years (from enrolment date) of honourable service with no serious infractions, and be recommended by the Cadet Corps Commanding Officer

## **VOLUNTEER SERVICE MEDAL (VSM)**

To qualify for this award, a member must have successfully completed a minimum five (5) continuous years of meritorious service with the Army Cadet Program and be recommended by the Branch or the National level where the member has served.

Pins commemorating additional years service (in 5 year increments) are also presented.

# **SCHOLARSHIP & BURSARIES**

## THE GERARD BUCKLEY CADET FUND

The purpose of the fund is to benefit Army Cadets in Canada. As an overriding principle, the monies must assist the greatest number of cadets possible in areas of training where The Government of Canada or The Department of National Defense does not provide funding. #### PRIZE/AWARD

Army Cadet Corps or their Support Committees may apply to receive one of four grants of \$3,000 that are awarded annually.

The Major Terence Whitty Memorial Bursary was created to assist an Army Cadet pursuing post-secondary education and in need of financial assistance.

\$1,000 awarded annually to a senior Army cadet (in the form of reimbursement for eligible expenses directly related to education)
